WITNESSETH:

The grantor irrevocably grants, bargains, sells and conveys to the trustee, in trust, with power of sale, the property in Klamath County, Oregon, described as:

This trust deed shall further secure the payment of such additional money, if any, as may be louned hereafter by the beneficiary to the grantor or others having an interest in the above described property, as may be evidenced by a note or notes. If the indebtedness secured by this trust deed is evidenced by more than one note, the beneficiary may credit payments received by it upon any of said notes or part of any payment on one note and part on another, as the beneficiary may elect.

The grantor covenants and agrees to pay said note according to the terms thereof and, when due, all taxes, assessments and other charges levted against said property; to keep add property free from all encumbrances having precedence over this trust deed; to complete all buildings in course of construction or hereafter constructed on said premises within six months from the date hereof or the date construction is hereafter commenced; to repair and restore promptly and in good workmanilke manner any building or improvement on said property which may be damaged or destroyed and pay, when due, all costs incurred therefor; to allow henefleiary to inspect said property at all times during construction; to replace any work or materials unsatisfactory to henefleiary within fifteen days after written notice from henefleiary of such fact; not to remove or destroy any building or improvements now or hereafter constructed on said premises; to keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter erected upon said property in good of the property and improvements now or hereafter erected on said premises continuously insured against loss by fire or such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in a sum not less than the original principal sum of the note or obligation secured by this trust deed, in a company or companies acceptable to the heneficiary, and to deliver the original policy of insurance in correct form and with approved loss payable clause in favor of the heneficiary materials unsurance is not so tendered, the heneficiary mile in its wards and property of insurance of the heneficiary which insurance shall be non-cancellable by the grantor during the full term of the policy thus obtained.

While the grantor is to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or assessed against said property, or any part thereof, before the same begin to hear interest and also to pay premiums on all insurance policies upon said property, such payments are to be made through the beneficiary to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or imposed against said property in the amounts as shown by the statements thereof turnished by the collector of such taxes, assessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance premiums in the amounts shown on the statements thereof turnished by the collector of such taxes, assessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance curriers or their representatives, and to charge said sums to the principal of the ions or to withdraw the sums which may be required from the reserve account, if any, established for that purpose. default, any blance remaining in the reserve account shall be credited to the indebtedness. If the reserve account for taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges is not sufficient at any time for the payment of such charges as they become due, the grantor shall pay the deflet to the beneficiary upon demand, and if not paid within ten days after such demand, the beneficiary may at its option add the amount of such deflett to the principal of the obligation secured hereby.

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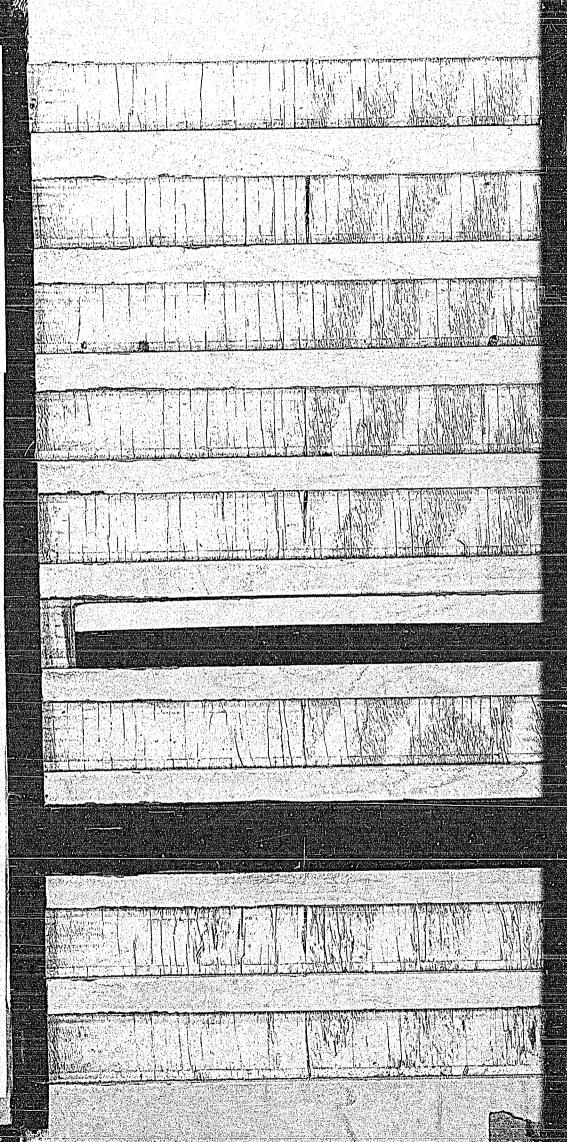
