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1 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That A. O. Roenicke and Dorothea B. Roenicke,
2 husband and wife, Grantors, in consideration of \$1.00 and other valuable con-
3 siderations paid them by the United States of America, Grantee, do hereby give
4 and grant unto Grantee the perpetual easement for irrigation canal purposes
5 over a strip of land sixty feet in width, the center line of which is described
6 as follows:

7 Beginning at a point 648 feet, more or less South of the corner
8 common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 39 S. R. 10 E.W.M.,
9 said point being in the canal as now constructed; thence meander-
10 ing southwesterly along the center line of said canal as now
11 constructed 900 feet, more or less, and parallel with the original
12 alignment of the "E" Canal of the U.S.R. S. Klamath Project, to a
13 point S. 27°55' West 1,307 feet, more or less, from the Northeast
14 corner of Section 14, Twp.39 S. R. 10 E.W.M., and containing 1.26
15 acres, more or less,

16 with the perpetual right to enter into and upon said land to maintain, operate
17 and repair said canal.

18 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto said grantee, and its successors and
19 assigns.

20 The consideration for this conveyance is \$1.00.
