1967/50 FORM No. 633—WARRANTY DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That EDGAR F. DOWNING and ANNA L. DOWNING, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by Modoc Veneer Co., an Oregon Corporation,

does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

S 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 11 E.W.M., Klamath County, Oregon.

SUBJECT TO: Easements and rights of way of record, and those apparent on the land, and, all future real property taxes; rights of the public in and to any portion of said premises lying within the limits of roads and highways.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns forever. And said grantor hereby covenants to and with said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above grunted premises, free from all encumbrances except as above set forth,

and that grantor will warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.
