

WARRANTY DEED TO CREATE ESTATE BY THE ENTIRETY

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This Indenture witnesseth, THAT NORMA B. TAYLOR, a single woman,

hereinafter known as grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated  
has bargained and sold by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
GEORGE RYZEK and BARBARA A. RYZEK,  
husband and wife, grantees, the following described premises, situated in Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit:  
Lot 27 in Block 8 of ELDORADO ADDITION TO THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, Klamath County,  
Oregon.

SUBJECT TO: (1) Conditions and restrictions contained in Deed from State of Oregon,  
by and through its State Highway Commission to Wilson Title & Abstract Co., Trustee,  
dated July 22, 1949, recorded June 9, 1950, in Deed Volume 239 at page 370. (2)  
Conditions and use and building restrictions as shown on the plat and dedication of  
Eldorado Addition. (3) Easement, including the terms and provisions thereof, from  
Donald L. Sloan, et ux, to Pacific Power & Light Company, formerly The California  
Oregon Power Company, a California corporation, dated May 31, 1950, recorded July  
17, 1950, in Deed Volume 240 at page 308. (4) Easement, including the terms and  
provisions thereof, from Donald L. Sloan, et ux, to Pacific Power and Light Company,  
formerly The California Oregon Power Company, a California corporation, dated November  
28, 1950, recorded December 1, 1950, in Deed Volume 243 at page 569. (5) Trust Deed,  
including the terms and provisions thereof, dated August 3, 1965, recorded August 5,  
1965, in M-65 at page 640, County Clerk Records, given to secure the payment of  
\$14,000.00, with interest thereon and such future advances as may be provided therein,  
executed by Claude H. Taylor and Norma B. Taylor, husband and wife, to Oregon Title  
Insurance Co., trustee for beneficiary, First National Bank of Oregon, the balance of  
which the grantees herein expressly assume and agree to pay in accordance with the  
terms and conditions thereof.

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The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$15,658.30.  
However, the actual consideration includes other property which is part of the consideration.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said grantees as an  
estate by the entirety. And the said grantor does hereby covenant, to and with the said grantees, and  
their assigns, that she is the owner in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from  
all incumbrances, except those above set forth,  
and that she will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever,  
except those above set forth.
