WHEREAS, Said matter was again heard on June 18, 1969, and was continued by Order of the Board of Commissioners until July 2, 1969; and

WHEREAS, On July 2, 1969, the hearing was continued indefinitely until such time as notice was received that the parties had reached an agreement and the Public Utilities Commission permit had been issued; and WHEREAS, By Order of the Board of County Commissioners dated the 31st day of October, 1969, said hearing was continued until the 5th day of November, 1969; at 3 ORDER, Page 1.
