This matter having come on regularly for hearing on this date before the court, plaintiff appearing in person and being represented by her attorney, Thomas H. Henderson, and the defendant not appearing and an order of default having been entered herein and the prosecuting attorney of Pierce County appearing by a deputy, and the court having heretofore entered its findings of fact and conclusions of law in writing, now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That this court has jurisdiction over the parties hereto and the subject matter of this action;

2. That the plaintiff be and she is hereby awarded an absolute and final decree of divorce from the defendant and the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between them are hereby fully and finally dissolved;

3. That the plaintiff be and she is hereby awarded the care, custody, and control of the minor child of the parties, with reasonable rights of visitation allowed to the defendant to be exercised by him at reasonable times and places, provided reasonable notice is furnished by defendant to plaintiff beforehand, including summer visitation during the summer, providing one month's notice before departure.

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1. Is furnished heretofore to plaintiff;

2. That the defendant he and he is hereby awarded as his sole and  
3. separate property all the community property of the parties, except the Kenmore  
4. washing machine which will be awarded to the plaintiff, together with his wear-  
5. ing apparel, jewelry, and personal items of property;

6. That the plaintiff he and she is hereby awarded as her sole and  
7. separate property the Kenmore washing machine and her wearing apparel,  
8. jewelry, and personal items of property;

9. That the defendant he and he is hereby required to pay the outstanding  
10. indebtedness of the parties, except the debt owing on the Kenmore washing  
11. machine, which plaintiff he and she is hereby required to pay;

12. That the defendant he and he is hereby required to pay to the plaintiff  
13. toward the support and maintenance of the minor child of the parties the amount  
14. of \$70 per month until said child is of legal age, married, or otherwise  
15. emancipated, or until further order of the court.
