CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Do to Certify, That, HARRY and VIRGINIA ROSE

of the County of Clatsop, State of Oregon, have duly applied to the State Engineer of Oregon for a right of appropriation of water from the public waters of the State, under Act of April 10, 1911, Chapter 10, Laws of 1911, and Act of March 1, 1920, Chapter 10, Laws of 1920.

The said application was filed in the office of the State Engineer of Oregon on the 10th day of October, 1959, and was accompanied by a map showing the location of the proposed right of appropriation.

The said application was found to conform to the requirements of the Act of April 10, 1911, Chapter 10, Laws of 1911, and Act of March 1, 1920, Chapter 10, Laws of 1920, and the right of appropriation was granted.

The right of appropriation is hereby granted to the said HARRY and VIRGINIA ROSE, for the purpose of irrigating the land owned by them, and for the purpose of domestic use.
