

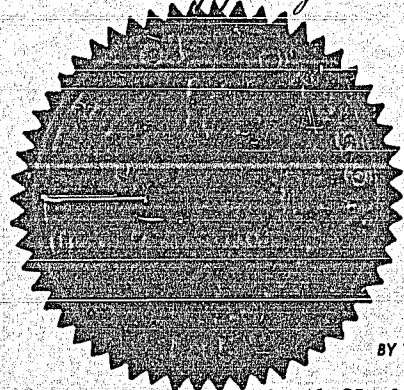


Notarial Commission
