WHEREAS, On the 26th day of January, 1970, a
 Petition for Vacation duly executed by Frank E. Peyton
 and Cecile Peyton, husband and wife, and Pacific Power
 and Light Company, a Corporation, was filed with the Board
 of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, By Affidavit of Posting, Earl E. Kessler
 has proved that proper Notice of Petition to Vacate and
 hearing thereon was properly posted on the Bulletin Board
 at the place of meeting of the Board of County Commissioners
 and at three public places in the vicinity of the proposed
 vacation; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners by
 Order did set a public hearing for 10:30 o'clock A.M., on
 March 4, 1970, in the Board of Commissioners' Hearing Room,
 at the Klamath County Court House, Klamath County, Oregon;
 that Notice thereof was posted on the 30th day of January,

and wife, all of the parties particularly affected thereby,
and that said Consents are on file herein; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held at 10:30 o'clock A.
M. on the 4th day of March, 1970, and no person appeared
and objected thereto; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners did
determine that it is in the best interests of all parties
that said lots and streets be vacated as prayed for in said
Petition, and that no harm will come to the general public
therefrom; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That all the lots in Blocks
8, 9, 10, and 11, the alley in Block 9 and Heather Street
(Sunrise Street) from Elk Avenue (Ailsa Avenue) to Dover
Avenue (Fairfield Avenue), and Elk Avenue (Ailsa Avenue)
from Greensprings Highway to Lilac Street (Kesterson Street),
and Lilac Street (Kesterson Street) from Dover Avenue (Fair-
field Avenue) South to deadend, be, and the same are here-
by vacated, subject to the reservation of all public utility
easements, if any existing upon said property on this date.
