The First Methodist Church (United) Presbyterian Church
of Merrill, Oregon being, on sufficient grounds, well

satisfied with the ministerial qualifications of you, Irvin Morris
and having good hopes from our knowledge of you, that your ministrations in the gospel will be profitable to our spiritual
interests, do earnestly call and desire you to undertake the office of pastor (Associate pastor) in said congregation, promising
you in the discharge of your duty all proper support, encouragement, and obedience in the Lord. Believing the continuing education
of ministers to be essential to good preaching and effective pastoral ministry, and as an incentive to encourage your efforts in this
matter, we will, after the conclusion of your first year of your ministry here, offer you two weeks time in addition to vacation away
from the parish at full salary provided they be used for academic work at an established educational institution or some equivalent
study program approved by the session. The study leave may be accumulated at the rate of two weeks per year served to remove
time for a longer period of study. And that you may be free from worldly care and avocations, we, on our part, promise and oblige

ourselves to pay you the sum of six thousand dollars
(\$ 6,000) yearly in regular payments during the time of your being and continuing the regular pastor (Associate pastor)

of this church, together with free use of a manse and one month vacation each year, with additional perquisites
as follows: six hundred dollars car allowance yearly, up to five hundred dollars moving
expense

In addition to which the church will pay \$ zero each year for expenses incurred in continuing education. And we agree
to pay or continue to pay monthly or quarterly in advance to the Board of Pensions a sum equivalent to that requisite per cent of
said salary which may be fixed by the General Assembly of The United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America for
participation in the United Presbyterian Pension Plan. And we promise and oblige ourselves to review with you the adequacy of
this compensation annually, prior to the adoption of the church budget.

In testimony whereof, and in conformity with the action of the congregation directing us to subscribe this call in their
behalf, we hereby respectively subscribe our names this 12 day of July, A.D. 1970
