ORDER.

WHEREAS, On the 13th day of July, 1970, the Board of Commissioners of Klamath County, Oregon, did on its own motion and pursuant to the provisions of ORS 368.565, declare its intention to vacate a portion of the County Road described in Commissioners' Journal III, Page 455, July 9, 1901, and by Order in Commissioners' Journal III, Page 475, September 5, 1901; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners did refer said matter to the County Engineer for his report, which said report approved vacation of said road to public road status as set forth in the Resolution of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, The Affidavit of Earl E. Kessler has proved that proper Notice of the Resolution to vacate and the hearing thereon was posted on the Bulletin Board at the place of meeting of the Board of Commissioners and at three public places in the vicinity of the road proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners did set the public hearing on the proposed vacation for the hour of 10:30 o'clock A.M., in the Board of Commissioners Hearing Room, Courthouse, Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon, on the 26th day of August, 1970, and that said Notices were so posted on the 23rd day of July, 1970, which said posting was more than thirty days prior to the time set for hearing; and

WHEREAS, The hearing was held at 10:30 o'clock A.M., on the 26th day of August, 1970, at which time it was determined that this road was not generally used by the public except for occasional recreation purposes; that other roads are being maintained which furnish access to the same southern terminals, and that the road is burdensome for the County to maintain as a part of its general County Road System; that the public would be benefitted if said road were vacated to public road status; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the County Road more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in Township 40 South, Range 6 East on the Klamath Falls and Ashland Road near the SW corner of Section 4 and running West to Pokegama; thence NW to a point near the quarter stake on Section 4, Township 40 South, Range 5 East connecting with Ashland and Klamath Falls Road, all as is set forth in Commissioners' Journal III, Page 475, on September 5, 1901.
