THE MORTGAGOR JAMES CRESWELL and CAROL G. CRESWELL, husband and wife,

mortgages to the STATE OF OREGON, represented and acting by the Director of Veterans' Affairs, pursuant to ORS 407.030, the following described real property located in the State of Oregon and County of Klamath.

PARCEL I: The SE₄SW₄ and Lots 7, 10 and 11 of Section 19; Lots 2, 7, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 and the NE₄SE₄ of Section 32; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Section 33; In Township 38 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian. The NE₂SE₄, SE₄NE₄, Lots 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, of Section 4, Township 39 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian.

PARCEL II: The SE₄NW₄ of Section 2; The NW₄SE₄, E₂NW₄ and the SW₄NE₄ of Section 3, in Township 39 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian.

together with the tenements, hereditaments, rights, privileges, and appurtenances including roads and easements used in connection with the premises; all electric, lighting, fuel, water and heating system, water heaters, fuel storage receptacles; plumbing, ventilation, water and irrigation systems; screens, doors; window shades and blinds, shutters; cabinets, built-ins, linoleums and floor coverings; built-in stoves, ovens, electric sinks, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers; and all fixtures now or hereafter installed in or on the premises; and any shrubbery, flora, or timber now growing or hereafter planted or growing thereon; and any replacements of any one or more of the foregoing items, in whole or in part, all of which are hereby declared to be appurtenant to the land, and all of the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged property;

to secure the payment of Sixty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars

\$66,850.00 ----, and interest thereon, evidenced by the following promissory note:

I promise to pay to the STATE OF OREGON Sixty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$66,850.00) ----, with interest from the date of initial disbursement by the State of Oregon, at the rate of four percent per annum on a principal balance of \$50,000.00 less and 6.4 percent per annum on the principal balance in excess thereof, principal and interest to be paid in lawful money of the

United States at the office of the Director of Veterans' Affairs in Salem, Oregon, as follows: \$4,324.00 ----- on or before November 1, 1971 ----- and \$4,324.00 on each November 1st -----

thereafter, plus ----- the ad valorem taxes for each successive year on the premises described in the mortgage, and continuing until the full amount of the principal, interest and advances shall be fully paid, such payments to be applied first as interest on the unpaid principal, the remainder on the principal.

The due date of the last payment shall be on or before November 1, 1998.

In the event of transfer of ownership of the premises or any part thereof, I will continue to be liable for payment and the balance shall draw interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 from date of such transfer.

This note is secured by a mortgage, the terms of which are made a part hereof.

The mortgagor or subsequent owner may pay all or any part of the loan at any time without penalty.

The mortgagor covenants that he owns the premises in fee simple, has good right to mortgage same, that the premises are free from encumbrances, that he will warrant and defend same forever against the claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, and this covenant shall not be extinguished by foreclosure, but shall run with the land.

MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

1. To pay all debts and monies secured hereby;
2. Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demolition of any buildings or improvements now or hereafter existing; to keep same in good repair; to complete all construction within a reasonable time in accordance with any agreement made between the parties hereto;
3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, fine, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
6. Mortgagor is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of the advances to bear interest as provided in the note;
7. To keep all buildings sufficiently insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards as such company, or companies, and in such amounts as shall be satisfactory to the mortgagor, to deposit with the mortgagor all such premiums, and receive a policy showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgagor; if the mortgagor fails to effect the insurance, the mortgagor may secure the insurance and the cost shall be added to the principal, deducted a first due and shall be secured by this mortgage; insurance shall be kept in force by the mortgagor in case of fire or enclosure until the period of redemption expires.

8. Mortgagee shall be entitled to all compensation and damages received under right of eminent domain, or for any security voluntarily released, same to be applied upon the indebtedness;

9. Not to lease or rent the premises, or any part of same, without written consent of the mortgagee;

10. To promptly notify mortgagee in writing of a transfer of ownership of the premises or any part of interest in same, and to furnish a copy of the instrument of transfer to mortgagee; any purchaser shall assume the indebtedness, and purchasers not entitled to a loan or 4% interest under ORS 407.010 to 407.210 shall pay interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 on all payments due from that date or before; in all other respects this mortgage shall remain in full force and effect; no transfer of the transfer shall be valid unless same contains a covenant of the grantee whereby the grantee assumes the covenants of this mortgage and agrees to pay the indebtedness secured by same.

The mortgagee may, at his option, in case of default of the mortgagor, perform same in whole or in part and all expenditures made in so doing including the employment of an attorney to secure compliance with the terms of the mortgage or the note shall draw interest at the rate provided in the note and all such expenditures shall be immediately repayable by the mortgagor without demand and shall be secured by this mortgage.

Default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained or the expenditure of any portion of the loan for purposes other than those specified in the application, except by written permission of the mortgagee given before the expenditure is made, shall cause the entire indebtedness at the option of the mortgagee to become immediately due and payable without notice and this mortgage subject to foreclosure.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right arising from a breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs incurred in connection with such foreclosure.

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgagee shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, collect the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgagee shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.

The covenants and agreements herein shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.

It is distinctly understood and agreed that this mortgage is subject to the provisions of Article XI-A of the Oregon Constitution, ORS 407.010 to 407.210 and any subsequent amendment thereto and to all rules and regulations which have been issued or may hereafter be issued by the Director of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to the provisions of ORS 407.020.

WORDS: The masculine shall be deemed to include the feminine, and the singular the plural where such connotations are applicable herein.
