CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARION B. PINNEO

of 1436 McClellan Drive, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 2

a tributary of Williamson River for the purpose of irrigation of 133.3 acres

under Permit No. G-3581 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T. 30 S., R. 8 E., W. M. Well located: 75 feet South and 50 feet East from NW Corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


