

WARRANTY DEED TO CREATE ESTATE BY THE ENTIRETY

This Indenture Witnesseth, THAT James E. Chaney and Wilda L. Chaney, husband and wife, hereinafter known as grantors, for the consideration hereinafter stated have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Richard Slagle and Margaret Slagle, husband and wife, grantees, the following described premises, situated in Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit:

A tract of land situated in Lot 28 HOMEDALE, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 28 HOMEDALE; thence North 46°27'05" East 150.06 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continuing North 46°27'05" East 70 feet; thence South 43°32'20" East 133.30 feet; thence South 46°27'05" West 70 feet; thence North 43°32'20" West 132.29 feet to the point of beginning.

Subject to: Regulations, including levies, assessments, water and irrigation rights and easements for ditches and canals, of Enterprise Irrigation District; Regulations, including levies, liens, assessments, rights of way and easements of the South Suburban Sanitary District.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$ 21,950.00
