

ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

FEB 25 10 42 AM 1972

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, a municipal corporation, grants to Pacific Power and Light Company, its successors and assigns, as grantee a non-exclusive encroachment permit to maintain a brick planter box as presently located upon that portion of Fifth Street, in the City of Klamath Falls, County of Klamath, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the most westerly corner of Lot 5, Block 37, Original Townsite Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; thence S 50°55'00" E along the southwesterly boundary of said Lot 5, a distance of 74.00 feet, to the true point of beginning; thence continuing S 50°55'00" E along said lot boundary, a distance of 26.00 feet; thence S 39°05'00" W, a distance of 0.10 feet, to a point; thence N 50°55'00" W, a distance of 26.00 feet, to a point; thence N 39°05'00" W, a distance of 0.10 feet, to the true point of beginning; the above-described area being located within the dedicated right-of-way of Fifth Street adjacent and contiguous to the northeasterly boundary thereof.

upon the following conditions:

1. That grantee shall hold the grantor harmless from all claims and demands from all persons as a result of said encroachment.
2. That this permit shall terminate if the above-described brick planter box is in any way altered, removed or destroyed.

The true and actual consideration for this permit is Twenty-Five and no/100ths (\$25.00) DOLLARS.

The foregoing recital of consideration is true as I verily believe.

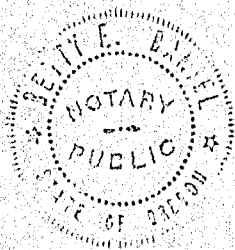
