INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT

OF DIVORCE BY DEFAULT

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard before the Honorable
JAMES P. MATOLI, Judge Pro Tem, Judge presiding in Department
Southeast "H", on August 25, 1969; ROBERT M. KAUFMAN appearing
as attorney for plaintiff, and it appearing that defendant was
duly served with process and has not appeared or answered the
complaint, and that the default of defendant has been entered;
and evidence having been introduced on the part of plaintiff,
and said cause having been duly submitted to the Court for
decision:

IT IS ADJUDGED that plaintiff is entitled to a divorce
from defendant; that when one year shall have expired in accord-
ance with 5132 Civil Code, a Final Judgment dissolving the marr-
iage between plaintiff and defendant be entered, and at that
time the Court shall grant such other and further relief as may
be necessary to complete disposition of this action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following property is
awarded to plaintiff, as her sole and separate property:

1. Family residence and real property located at 14920
Badlona Drive, La Mirada, California; better known and described
as:

"Lot No. 126 of Tract 17945 as per Map recorded in Book 544;
Pages 12-25 of Maps recorded in the office of the Los Angeles
County Recorder's Office."

2. Real property located in the County of Klamath,
State of Oregon, better known and described as:

"Lots 14 and 15, Block 47, First Addition to Klamath Forest
Estates as recorded in Klamath County, Oregon, in Book
M-67 on Page 21 of Record of Deeds of said County."

3. Real property located in the County of Deschutes,
State of Oregon, described as:

"Lot Five (5) Block One (1) DESCHUTES RIVER RECREATION
HOMESITES, together with a 1/1224 interest as tenants
in common in the following described parcels:

PARCEL 1: Lot 1, Block 2 Deschutes River Recreation
Homesites, Inc., Deschutes County, Oregon
as filed October 11, 1961;

PARCEL 2: Recreation Area, official plat of Block 9,
Deschutes River Recreation Homesites, Inc.,
Deschutes County, Oregon, as filed October
18, 1962;

PARCEL 3: Recreation Area and Boat Docking Facilities
corrected Plat of Deschutes River Recreation
Homesites, Inc., Deschutes County, Oregon,
as filed May 16, 1963;

Subject to reservations, restrictions, easements and rights
of way of record, as recorded in Book 156, on Page 512 of
record of Deeds of said County."

4. All the household furniture, furnishings and
appliances and contents in the family home located at 14920
Badlona Avenue, La Mirada, California; and

5. The 1966 Renault automobile, bearing California
license TFC-431.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant is hereby enjoined
and restrained from bothering, molesting, annoying, harassing or
interfering with plaintiff, in any manner whatsoever; including
returning to the family residence located at 14920 Badlona Avenue,

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1 La Mirada, California.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant shall execute any
3 necessary documents in connection with the conveyance of the
4 aforementioned property as per this Decree, and if defendant
5 fails to sign such documents by the time of entry of the Final
6 Decree, the Clerk of this Court shall be empowered to sign his
7 name to any and all such documents.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon entry of the Final
9 Decree herein, plaintiff is allowed the restoration of her former
10 name, to wit, ROSITA LAMSON.

11 THE CLERK IS ORDERED TO ENTER THIS DECREE.
