That there were no surviving children of any deceased children.

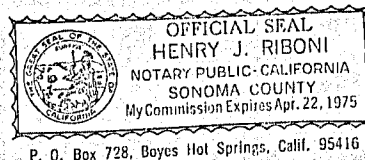
