wise appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

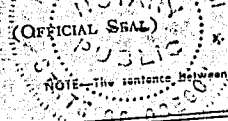
Lot 157, Sportsman Park 3rd, Klamath County, Oregon.
