The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Lakeview, Oregon, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of **Ebene H. Gifford** has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and the east half of the southeast quarter of Section twenty-nine in Township forty south of Range twelve east of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing one hundred sixty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said land, deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Survey General, NOW KNOW YE, that there is hereby granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereto, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant, forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with said water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and regulations of said State, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
