Abstract 00300 and 00301

The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Lafayette, Oregon, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Benjamin John Daniel has been established and duly commuted, in conformity to law, for the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section nineteen, the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section twenty-nine, the west half of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section twenty, and the north half of the northeast quarter of Section thirty in Township forty south of Range twelve east of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing three hundred twenty acres,

According to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of Land above described; and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights in ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Woodrow Wilson, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, in the District of Columbia, the TWENTY-EIGHTH day of FEBRUARY in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and NINETEEN and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and FORTY-THIRD.
