

Privilege is reserved to pay the debt in whole, or in an amount equal to one or more monthly payments on the principal that are next due on the note, on the first day of any month prior to maturity: Provided, however, That written notice on an intention to exercise such privilege is given at least thirty (30) days prior to prepayment; and provided further. 
