

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned, hereinafter designated the "claimant", did, between the dates of June 29, 1972, and September 26, 1972, perform labor for and at the special instance and request of Mayfair Market #485 also known as Oregon Food Stores, Inc., an Oregon Corporation hereinafter designated the "builder", in the construction, alteration and/or repair of that certain building and/or improvement known as Mayfair Market #485

located upon certain land situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, and described as follows:

That at the time claimant commenced to perform said labor Oregon Food Stores, Inc., an Oregon Corporation was the owner or reputed owner of the above described land and the building and improvements thereon and had knowledge of, and consented to, the construction, alteration and/or repair of said building and/or improvement, and Oregon Food Stores, Inc. is still

is now the owner or reputed owner of the above described land and the building and improvements thereon and had knowledge of, and consented to, the construction, alteration and/or repair of said building and/or improvement.

That the said builder had charge of said construction, alteration and/or repair.

That the contract price and reasonable value of said labor performed by the claimant as aforesaid was and is the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Three and 56/100 Dollars lawful money of the United States and there is now due the claimant for said labor performed, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Four Thousand One Hundred Fifty and 56/100 Dollars.

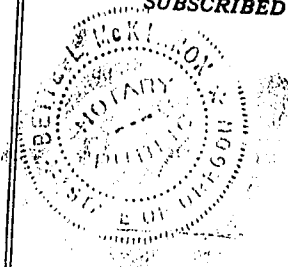
