KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, hereinafter called "Grantor", for the consideration hereinafter stated, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto VANCE HALL and BARBARA HALL, husband and wife, hereinafter called "Grantees", and Grantees' heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

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

Except as to the mineral reservations hereinabove set forth, the Grantor hereby expressly saves, excepts and reserves out of the grant hereby made, unto itself, its successors and assigns, forever, all ores and minerals of any nature whatsoever in or upon said land, including, but not limited to, coal, oil and gas, together with the right to enter upon said lands for the purpose of exploring the same for such ores and minerals and for the purpose of drilling, opening, developing and working mines and wells thereon and taking out and removing therefrom all such ores and minerals and to occupy and make use of so much of the surface of said land as may be reasonably necessary for said purposes; provided that the Grantees and the Grantees' heirs, representatives, successors and assigns, shall be paid just and reasonable compensation for any injury or damage to the surface of said land, to the crops or to the improvements thereon caused by the exercise of any rights herein reserved; provided, further, that the exercise of such rights by the Grantor shall not be postponed or delayed pending reasonable efforts to agree upon or
