TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

WHEREAS, Samuel S. Thorpe granted to the United States of America an easement for a road, dated October 1, 1931, and recorded in Klamath County, Oregon, in Vol. 97, Page 135, which easement contained the following provisions:

This grant shall be effective only so long as said easement shall be actually used for any of the purposes above specified, but all rights hereunder shall revert to the owner of the fee as soon as the said use thereof shall be abandoned and discontinued.

WHEREAS, the undersigned has determined that the United States of America has no further need for said easement.

NOW THEREFORE, this instrument is executed for the purpose of showing that it has been determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement and that the easement pursuant to its provisions has ceased and terminated and is hereby canceled.
