

WHEREAS, Ellingson Lumber Company granted to the United States of America an easement for a road, dated January 24, 1967, and recorded in Klamath County, Oregon, in Vol. M-67, Page 632, which easement contained the following provisions:

The rights, privileges and authorities herein granted are for the purpose of removing National Forest products from the proposed Gravel Pit timber sale area estimated to be approximately 390 M board feet. This grant shall continue as long as needed, for the purpose of removing the above designated timber, and said grant shall expire upon the termination of the resultant timber sale agreement.

WHEREAS, the undersigned has determined that the United States of America has no further need for said easement.

NOW THEREFORE, this instrument is executed for the purpose of showing that it has been determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement and that the easement pursuant to its provisions has ceased and terminated and is hereby canceled.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America, by its Regional Forester, Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, has executed this instrument on this 3 day of April, 1973.
