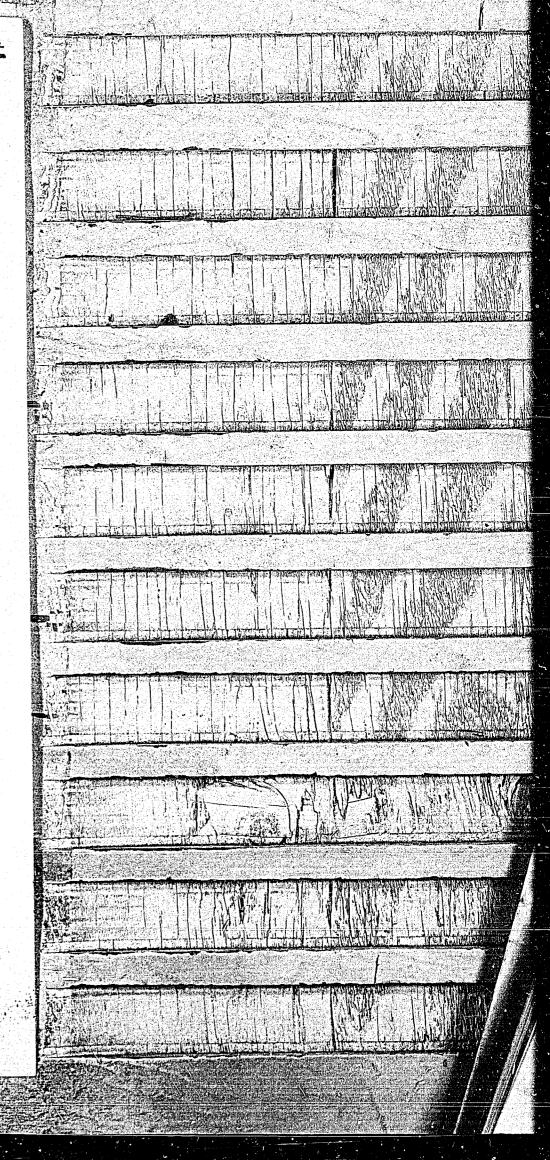

MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

- Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demolishment of any buildings or improvements now or hereafter existing; to keep same in good repair; to complete all construction within a reasonable time in accordance with any agreement made between the parties hereto;
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of the advances to bear interest as provided in the note;
- 7. To keep all buildings unceasingly insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards in such company or companies and in such an amount as shall be satisfactory to the mortgage; to deposit with the mortgagee all such policies with receipts showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgagee; insurance shall be kept in force by the mortgagor in case of forcelosure until the period of redemption expires;

To promptly notify mortgagee in writing of a transfer of ownership of the premises or any part or interest in same, and to furnish a copy of the instrument of transfer to the mortgagee; a purchaser shall pay interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 on all payments due from the date of transfer; in all other respects this mortgage shall remain in full force and effect.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a walver of any right arising from a breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs red in connection with such foreclosure.
