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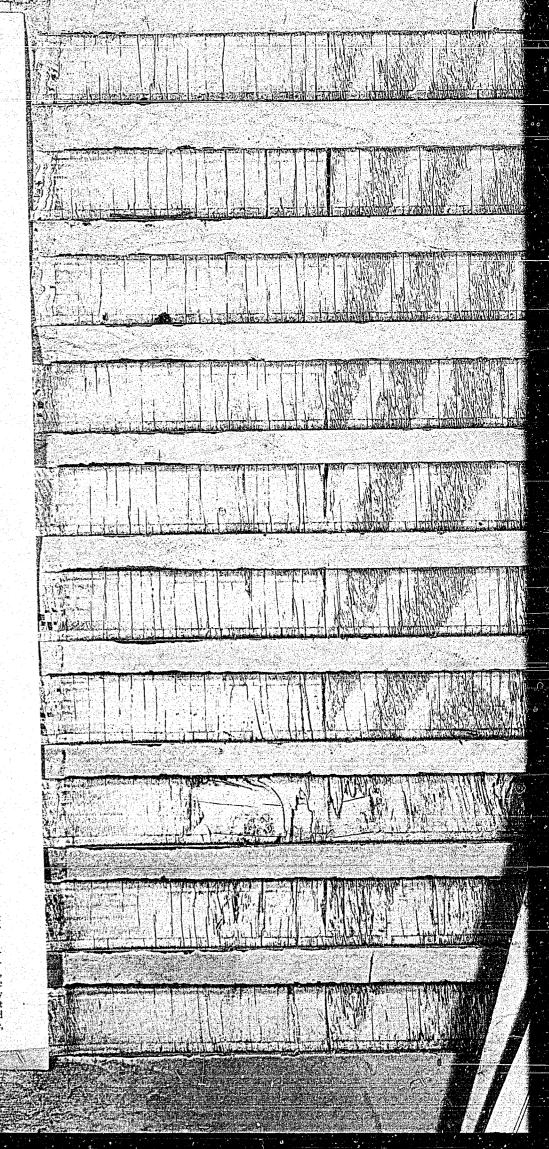

Further, in any suit to foreclose this trust deed or in any suit or proceedings in which Beneficiary defends or protects its security hereunder, or in which Beneficiary is a party and the property or any part thereof is the subject matter thereof, including suits to quiet title or for condemnation or partition of the whole or part of the property, or any interest therein, or in the event of any measures taken in connection with a sale or intended sale pursuant to the power granted hereunder, Grantors agree to pay to Beneficiary all costs and expenses and a reasonable sum as attorney's fees, including fees on appeal, and further agree to pay reasonable costs of title search incurred in the foregoing.

Beneficiary from time to time may appoint a successor or successors to any Trustee named herein or to any successor Trustee, such appointee to have the title, powers and duties conferred hereunder.

Neither the exercise, the failure to exercise or the waiver of any right or option granted Beneficiary hereunder shall constitute a waiver of any continuing or future default, any notice of default, any other right or remedy of Beneficiary, or this provision, nor shall the aforesaid invalidate or prejudice any act done pursuant to default or notice of default. All rights and remedies of Beneficiary hereunder shall be cumulative.
