to secure the payment of Twenty Eight Thousand and no/100----


(\$ 28,000.00----) and interest thereon, evidenced by the following promissory note:

- 1. To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby;
- Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demprovements now or hereafter existing; to keep same in good repair; to complete all construct accordance with any agreement made between the parties hereto;
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
