

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, JOHN GEORGE WHITELINE, a resident of the County of Sacramento, State of California, hereby make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, and revoke all other Wills and Codicils previously made by me.

FIRST: I declare that I am married and my wife's name is DOROTHY JANE WHITELINE, and I have two children now living, namely JOHN STEVEN WHITELINE, born February 7, 1944; and DIANA JANE WHITELINE, born October 20, 1946, and I have no deceased children.

SECOND: It is my intention to dispose of all real and personal property which I have the right to dispose of by Will, including any and all property as to which I may have a power of appointment by Will.

THIRD: I direct that all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral, shall be paid out of my estate by my executrix or executor hereinafter named.

FOURTH: All of my estate, real, personal and mixed, of whatsoever character or kind, and wheresoever situated, which I now own, may hereafter acquire, or have the right to dispose of at the time of my death, excepting Thirty (30) shares of Pacific Power and Light stock, mentioned in Paragraph Fifth of this my last Will and Testament, I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, DOROTHY JANE WHITELINE, provided, however, that in the event my said wife shall not survive me for six months, or should we die at the same time or as a result of the same accident, disaster, or common calamity, or during a joint last illness or under such circumstances that the order of our deaths cannot be ascertained, then and in any of such events, I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of that part of my estate so given to her, to my son, JOHN STEVEN WHITELINE, and my daughter, DIANA JANE WHITELINE, share and share alike.

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1 FIFTH: I give, devise, and bequeath to my son, JOHN STEVEN
2 WHITELINE, and my daughter, DIANA JANE WHITELINE, the thirty (30)
3 shares of stock or any increases thereto now owned by me in the
4 Pacific Power and Light Company, which they shall hold in the event
5 of my death, share and share alike.

6 SIXTH: I declare that except as otherwise provided in this
7 will, I have intentionally omitted to provide herein for any of
8 my heirs.

9 SEVENTH: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife,
10 DOROTHY JANE WHITELINE, as executrix of this my Last Will and Testa-
11 ment, and hereby direct that she be permitted to serve without bond;
12 provided, however, that in the event my said wife shall fail, be
13 unable or refuse to act as such Executrix, then in such event, I
14 hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife's sister, MRS.
15 BEVERLY JOYCE CRAPO, of 2415 N. Alberta Street, Portland 17, Oregon,
16 as the Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, and hereby
17 direct that she be permitted to serve without bond.

18 EIGHTH: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife,
19 DOROTHY JANE WHITELINE, as the guardian of the person and property
20 of my minor children, and direct that she be permitted to serve in
21 such capacity without bond; provided, however, that in the event
22 my said wife, DOROTHY JANE WHITELINE should be unable, fail, or
23 refuse to act in such capacity, then and in any of these events, I
24 hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife's sister, MRS.
25 BEVERLY JOYCE CRAPO, as the guardian of the persons and property
26 of my children during their minority and hereby direct that she
27 need not furnish any bond to act in such capacity; provided further
28 that in the event my wife's sister, BEVERLY JOYCE CRAPO, should
29 fail, refuse, or be unable to serve in such capacity, I hereby nom-
30 inate, constitute, and appoint my wife's brother, LESLIE JACK
31 O'KEEFE, of 4460 Winding Way, Sacramento 21, California, as the
32 guardian of the persons and property of my minor children, and

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1 hereby direct that he be permitted to serve in such capacity with-
 2 out bond.

3 NINTH: If any provision of this Will or of any Codicil should
 4 be invalid, it is my intention that all of the remaining provisions
 5 thereof shall continue to be fully effective.

6 This Will was signed by me on the 11th day of February,
 7 1963, in the County of Sacramento, State of California.
