

This matter having come on for hearing upon the application of Alvin Sperling for a change of zone, said change application being numbered Zone Change 73-75 and said application having been heretofore recommended from RD 5,000 (Residential Single Family) zone to C-5 (Highway Commercial) zone by the Klamath County Planning Commission, a description of the real property referred to in said application being marked Exhibit A, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, and a public hearing on said application having been regularly held on October 2, 1973 before said Board of Commissioners, and the Board of Commissioners having heard and examined the statements and evidence both oral and documentary introduced at said public hearing by the applicant, interested parties, the Planning Commission and the Planning Department, and the Board of Commissioners finding, as required by Ordinance Number 17, the same being the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance:

- 1. That the applicant has provided information showing that there is a public need for said zone change and that said real property is best suited of available properties to meet said need; and
- 2. The property affected by the change of zone is adequate in size and shape to facilitate those uses normally allowed in conjunction with such zoning; and
- 3. The property affected by the proposed change of zone is properly related to streets and highways to adequately serve the type of traffic generated by such uses that may be permitted therein; and
- 4. The proposed change of zone will have no adverse effect on any property or the permitted uses thereof, within a seven hundred (700) foot radius excluding highways and rights-of-way; and



5. That the proposed change of zone is in keeping with any land use plans duly adopted and does, in effect, represent the highest, best and most appropriate use of the land affected; and

6. That the application is consistent with the Klamath County adopted Comprehensive Land Use Plan maps and text,
