Jackson was last involved in unlawful conduct, and during that period of time he has established a home and family; and

PARDON

WHEREAS, Philip D. Jackson through his employment and participation in the activities of his community has become a respected and productive citizen; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Constitution requires that laws for the punishment of crime shall be founded on principles of reformation and rehabilitation, and not of vindictive justice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, and by virtue of the authority vested in me, I, TOM McCALL, Governor of the State of Oregon, hereby grant a full pardon to Philip D. Jackson with respect to the crimes enumerated above, restoring to him all the rights and privileges heretofore enjoyed by him under the laws of the state.
