Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 28,

This motion is based upon the following facts:

a Citation therefore which was filed with the Klamath County Clerk's office on January 17, 1960. Thereafter the guardianship of Stanley Elmo Lobert (Klamath County Number 58-80-G) was closed. A copy of the Petition and Citation are respectly marked Exhibits A and B and attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

2. The said Donald W. Knoke was also the Guardian for D. Webster Knoke a half brother of the said Stanley Elmo Lobert. By way of Petition filed with the Klamath County Clerk on October 15, 1969 the said Donald W. Knoke petitioned the Court for an Order authorizing the purchase of the above described real property for the sum of \$3,000. An Order authorizing the purchase of the above described real property was signed by the Honorable L. Sisemore on October 13, 1969 and filed with the Klamath County Clerk on October 15, 1969. Copies of this Petition and Order are marked respectively Exhibits C and D and by this reference incorporated herein.

3. No return of sale was ever filed in either the Guardianship of Stanley Elmo Lobert (Klamath County Number 58-80-G) or the subsequently opened Conservatorship of Stanley Elmc Lobert (Klamath

4. The valuation placed upon the land above described was arbitrary and without foundation and no showing was made to the true

5. The transfer by Donald W. Knoke from the Guardianship of his Ward Stanley Elmo Lobert to the Guardianship of his son D. Webster Knoke benefited an heir of the said Donald W. Knoke and indirectly, Donald W. Knoke himself. Two - Motion for the Return of Real Property

8. That no determination of consent was made pursuant to the provisions of ORS 126.471.




