- 1. Temporary Permit shall run for a period of five (5) years from date of recording, or until superseded by such other permanent zoning provisions as may be initiated by the applicant and approved by the Planning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners; and
- 2. The applicant shall construct a five-foot (5) fence along the north property line; and
- 3. The applicant shall screen any and all outside storage material by constructing a 100% sight-obscuring fence at least six (6) feet in height which shall completely enclose the outside storage area, and further that the material stored outside shall not extend more than two (2) feet higher than said fence; and
- 4. The applicant shall fill and gravel the rear yard in a manner suitable to serve as a parking lot; and
- 5. The applicant shall comply with requirements of the Office of the State Fire Marshal's Inspection Notice No. 09182 dated March 15, 1974, a copy of which is marked Exhibit A, altached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.
