KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, a duly authorized officer acting on and in behalf of PACIFIC CRUSHING CO., an Oregon corporation, doing business as KLAMATH PAVING CO., hereby declares that the aforesaid Pacific Crushing Co., an Oregon corporation, doing business as Klamath Paving Co., did, between July 20, 1973 and July 21, 1974, furnish services, labor, work, equipment and materials as itemized hereinbelow, for use in excavating, grading, paving (and in connection therewith) and otherwise preparing the following described land for construction, improvements and other purposes:

Weyerhaeuser Company yard and log storage area, known by those parties familiar with the location as the Weyerhaeuser Company Bly Yard, located on, adjacent or near to Highway 140 at or near the city of Bly, Oregon, further located by being in Section 34, Township 36 South, Range 14 East, West of the Willamette Meridian, substantially in the northern one-half thereof, and also further particularized as Tax Lots 200 and 500.
