

This matter having come on for hearing upon the application of James Flowers for Flowers Brothers, Inc. for a zone correction, said correction application being numbered Zone Correction 74-54 and said application having been heretofore recommended from AF (Agriculture 5 Forestry) zone to SP-12 (Public Facilities) zone by the Klamath County 18 Planning Commission because of a mapping error, a description of the <u>54</u> real property referred to in said application being marked Exhibit A, 77 attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, and a public 岛 hearing on said application having been regularly held on September 3, 138 1974, before the Board of Commissioners, and it appearing to said Board of Commissioners from the testimony, reports, and information produced at said hearing by the applicant, the Planning Commission and Planning Department, that the application should be granted, the Board of Commissioners makes the following findings of fact: 1. Flowers Brothers, Inc. had opened and operated a commercial gravel pit and rock quarry for the quarrying, processing, and sale of rock products beginning in 1967, before the adoption of county-wide zoning on December 7, 1972. 2. The Land Use Study preceding the adoption of zoning had not included the applicant's property and could not have properly designated the SP-12 zone. 3. Section 11.007 and Article 112, as amended, of Ordinance No. 17, requires that Klamath County initiate correction of mapping errors on the zoning map.
