

MECHANIC'S LIEN

Contributions to Employee Benefit Plan: Oregon-Washington Carpenters-Employers Trust Funds

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Trustees of the Oregon-Washington Carpenters-Employers Health and Welfare Trust Fund, Pension Trust Fund, Vacation-Savings Trust Fund and Apprenticeship and Training Trust Fund, through the undersigned Trust Coordinator, claim a Mechanic's Lien against real property as follows:

1. At the special instance and request of Jacobs & Moseley Construction Co., employees, whether Union or non-union, as defined in and covered by the Carpenters Master Labor Agreement for the State of Oregon performed labor in the construction, alteration and/or repair of that certain building and/or improvement located upon certain lands situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, and described as follows:

Tax Lot 1401, Code 41, Map 3909-0242, Kielsmeier Acre Tract, E. 30 ft. of Lot 3 and a portion of Lot 4, consisting of .85 acres, Klamath County, Oregon.

2. At all time said employees commenced to perform said labor, Eli Luria, was the owner or the reputed owner of the above-described land and the buildings and improvements thereon and had knowledge of and consented to, the construction, alteration and/or repair of said building and/or improvement.

3. As a result of the labor performed or the work done by said employees, contributions became due on September 25, 1974, to the aforesaid Trust Funds.

4. The following is a true statement of the Trustees' demand, after deducting all just credits and offsets:

The Trustees, through the undersigned, claim a lien for the total amount of \$283.08 listed above, upon the building and/or improvement hereinafore described and upon the land upon which said building and/or improvement is located together with a convenient space about the same, or so much as may be required for the convenient use and occupation thereof, to be determined by the judgment of the Circuit Court at the time of the foreclosure of this lien.

6. The statutory time in which the Trustees have to make and file this claim of lien, on said property, with the Court Clerk of the County in which said land is situated, has not expired.
