AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF UERLINGS STREET BETWEEN NORTH SEVENTH AND COOK STREETS, ALL IN THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO.

WHEREAS, on October 7, 1974, pursuant to Resolution No. 2262, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, held a public hearing on a proposal to vacate a portion of Uerlings Street, between North Seventh and Cook Streets, all in the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls has determined that it is to the best interest of the City that said street be vacated; therefore,

THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

That portion of Uerlings Street to be vacated is more particularly described as follows:

Section 1.

Beginning at a point on the East line of Block 95, Buena Vista Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, said point being the intersection of the said East line of Block 95, and the northwesterly extension of the southwesterly right-of-way line of Seventh Street, as shown on the plat of said First Addition; Thence southeasterly, along said extension of Seventh Street right-of-way line, to the most northerly corner of said Block 2, First Addition; Thence southerly, along the westerly line of said Block 2, to the most southerly corner of said Block 2, said corner also being a point on the northwesterly right-of-way of Cook Street, as shown on the plat of said First Addition; Thence southwesterly, along the southwesterly extension of the said northwesterly right-of-way line of Cook Street, to its intersection with the southeasterly extension of the northeasterly right-of-way line of Siskiyou Street, shown as Campo Street on said plat of Buena Vista Addition; Thence northwesterly, along said extension of Siskiyou Street right-of-way line, to the most southerly corner of said Block 95; Thence northerly, along the East line of said Block 95, to the point of beginning.

Time being of the essence, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and its approval by the Mayor.

Section 2.

Passed by the Common Council of the City of K'amath Falls, Oregon, this 21st day of October, 1974.
