To keep all buildings unceasingly insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards in such company or companies and in such an amount as shall be satisfactory to the mortgagee; to deposit with the mortgagee all such policies with receipts showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgagee; insurance shall be kept in force by the mortgage in case of foreclosure until the period of redemption expires;

The mortgagee may, at his option, in case of default of the mortgagor, perform same in whole or in part and all expenditures made in so doing including the employment of an attorney to secure compliance with the terms of the mortgage or the note shall demand and shall be secured by this mortgage.

Default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained or the expenditure of any portion of the loan for other than those specified in the application, except by written permission of the mortgagee given before the expenditure shall cause the entire indebtedness at the option of the mortgagee to become immediately due and payable without notice mortgage subject to foreclosure.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs incurred in connection with such foreclosure.

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgage shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, collect the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgages shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.
