The E 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 40 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, and the W 1/2 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 40 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, and a parcel of land being a strip of land 40 feet in width lying along the full length of the East side of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 9 Township 40 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian.

PARCEL 1: A portion of the Northeast 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of Section 21, Township 39 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Northeast 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of said Section 21; thence South along the East boundary of said Northeast 1/4 of Southwest 1/4, 1180.0 feet, more or less, to the Easterly boundary of the C-4-c-1 lateral of the U.S.B.R.; thence North 12°16' West, along the East boundary of said lateral, 1180 feet, more or less, to the North boundary of said Northeast 1/4 of Southwest 1/4; thence East, 243.2 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, being all of that portion of the Northeast 1/4 of SW 1/4 Section 21, Township 39 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying East of said lateral.
