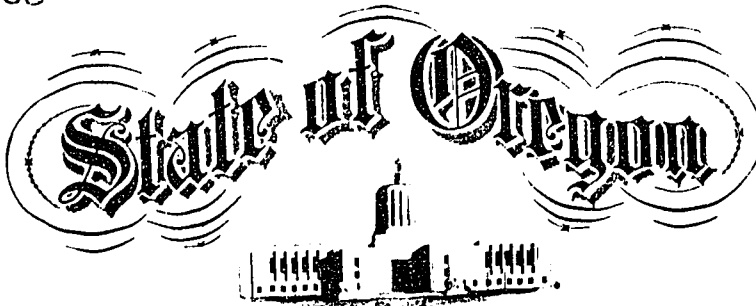

To all to Whom These Presents Shall Come-Greeting:

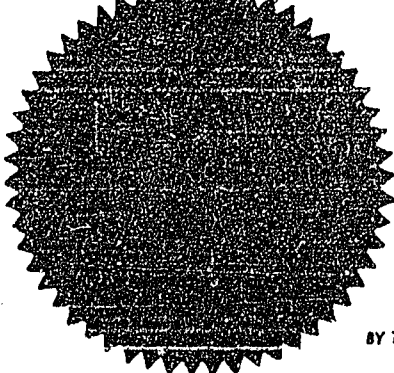
Know Ye,
