This matter was heard on its merits on Sept 7, 1973.
 Petitioner was represented by appeared in person without counsel,
 attorney of record; respondent *(appeared by
attorney of record) (did not appear in person or by attorney) (appeared by
non-appearing respondent) (appeared in person without counsel). The Court
 has examined the record, heard the evidence and the statements of counsel,
 and based thereon, makes the following findings:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of this action.
2. One of the parties, WIFE AND HUSBAND has been a resident of this state, for ninety days preceding the commencement of this proceeding.
3. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken.
4. The separation agreement between the parties, *(a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if set forth verbatim) has been considered by the Court and is not unconscionable as to support, maintenance, and property.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that a decree of dissolution be entered, and the marriage between the parties hereto is hereby dissolved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall perform the respective provisions of the separation agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if set forth verbatim, as apply to each of them.†

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the custody of the minor children Donald E. Porter, Son and Vicki R. Porter, Daughter be granted to the Father, Vernon A. Porter.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Court that #
 Property be disposed of as set forth in Exhibit A. Maintenance not be awarded Carole J. Porter, Wife.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT THIS COURT RETAINS SUCH JURISDICTION OF THIS ACTION AS IS PROVIDED BY LAW.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

James D. Thomas

Come now the Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER, and the Wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER, and stipulate and agree as follows:

WITNESSETH:

The parties are husband and wife. They were married on December 18, 1959, at Denver, Colorado. Of the issue of their marriage, there are two surviving children, namely, DONALD ERVAN PORTER, age fourteen years, and VICKI RUTH PORTER, age eleven years.

In consequence of disputes and irreconcilable differences, the parties have separated and are now living apart. In view of their intention to live apart for the rest of their natural lives, they desire to agree on custody of the minor children and other matters incidental to the dissolution of their marriage. Therefore the parties agree:

1. SEPARATION: The parties shall at all times hereafter continue to live separate and apart, free from interference by each other. Each party may reside at the place or places he or she may select.
2. CUSTODY OF CHILDREN: The husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER, shall have permanent care, custody, and control of the minor children of the parties, DONALD ERVAN PORTER and VICKI RUTH PORTER, reserving unto the wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER, the right of reasonable visitation with said children.
3. ALIMONY: The husband and wife hereby agree that no alimony or separate maintenance will be paid to the wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER.
4. CHILD SUPPORT: The husband and wife agree that no child support will be paid to the husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER.
5. PERSONAL PROPERTY: The husband and wife agree that the husband shall

have the exclusive use and ownership of the household furniture, furnishings, and other possessions acquired by the parties during their marriage, and which are now in the husband's possession and control. The husband shall retain possession, financial responsibility, and up keep of all properties acquired by the parties during their marriage. The Wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER, agrees and hereby waives all rights of joint ownership of properties located at 6216 Shasta Way, Klamath Falls, Oregon, 97601; and unimproved lot located at Canyon Lake near Spring Branch, Texas. The Wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER, agrees and hereby waives all rights of joint ownership of various vehicles owned jointly by parties and acquired during their marriage. It is further agreed that necessary legal transfer of ownership of properties and vehicles will occur in an expeditious and timely manner upon final Judgement of Dissolution of Marriage. The Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER, agrees to accept full and sole financial responsibilities for all property and vehicles.

6. DEBTS AND LIABILITIES: It is mutually agreed by the parties hereto that, other than as specifically set out in this agreement, each party shall hereafter be responsible for his or her own individual debts and liabilities, and agree to hold each other harmless from these debts and liabilities. All debts incurred prior to the separation of the parties shall be the responsibility of the Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER.

7. The Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER, and Wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER, respectfully request the Court to insert the details of this Agreement verbatim in any final Judgement of Dissolution of Marriage rendered herein.
