

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that a decree of dissolution be entered, and the marriage between the parties hereto is hereby dissolved. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall perform the respective risions of the separation agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if set forth verbatim, as apply to each of them.+ IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the custody of the minor children be granted to the Father, Vernon A. It is further agreed that necessary legal transfer of ownership of properties and vehicles will occur in an expeditious and timely manner upon final Judgement of Dissolution of Marriage. The Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER, agrees to accept full and sole financial responsibilities for all property and vehicles.

- 6. DEBTS AND LIABILITIES: It is mutually agreed by the parties hereto that, other that as specifically set out in this agreement, each party shall hereafter be responsible for his or her own individual debts and liabilities, and agree to hold each other harmless from these debts and liabilities. All debts incurred prior to the separation of the parties shall be the responsibility of the Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER.
- 7. The Husband, VERNON ARTHUR PORTER, and Wife, CAROLE JANE PORTER, respectfully request the Court to insert the details of this Agreement verbetim in any final Judgement of Dissolution of Marriage rendered herein.
