This trust deed shall further secure the payment of such additional money, if any, as may be loaned hereafter by the beneficiary to the grantor or others having an interest in the above described property, as may be evidenced by a note or notes. If the indebtedness secured by this trust deed is evidenced by more than one note, the beneficiary may credit payments received by it upon any of said notes or part of any payment on one note and part on another, as the beneficiary may elect.

The grantor hereby covenants to and with the trustee and the beneficiary herein that the said premises and property conveyed by this trust deed are free and clear of all encumbrances and that the grantor will and his heirs, executors and undministrators shall warrant and defend his said title thereto against the claims of all persons whomsoever.

In order to provide regularly for the prompt payment of said taxes, assessments or other charges and insurance premiums, the grantor agrees to pay to the beneficiary, together with and in addition to the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note or obligation secured hereby, an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12th) of the taxes, assessments and other charges due and payable with respect to said property within each succeeding twelve months, and also one-thirty-sixth (1/36th) of the insurance premiums payable with respect to said property within each succeeding three years while this trust deed remains in effect, as estimated and directed by the boneficiary such sums to be credited to the principal of the loan unit required for the several purposes thereof and shull thereupon be charged to the principal of the hendiciary in trust as a reserve account, without interest, to pay addipremiums, taxes, assessments or other charges when they shall become due and payable.

White the granter is to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or assessed against said property, or any part thereof, before the same begin do been intents and also to pay premiums on all insurance policity property, such payments are to be made through the beneficiary to pay the same property. The granter hereby authorizes the beneficiary to pay pay and all taxes, assessments and other charges levide or imposed against said property in the amounts as shown by the statements thereof furnished by the collector of such taxes, assessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance premiums in the amounts shown on the statements submitted by the insurance carriers or their representatives, and to charge said sums to the principal of the loan or to withdraw the sums which may be required from the reserve account, if any, established for that purpose. The granter agrees in no event to hold the beneficiary responsible for failure to have any insursurance policy, and the beneficiary hereby is authorized, in the event of any such insurance receipts upon the obligations accured by this trust deed. In full or upon sale or other acquisition of the property by the beneficiary after

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Should the grantor fail to keep any of the foregoing covenants, then the beneficiary may at its option carry out the same, and all its expenditures therefor shall draw interest at the rate specified in the note, shall be repayable by the grantor on demand and shall be secured by the lien of this trust deed. In this connection, the heneficiary shall have the right in its discretion to complete any improvements made on said premises and also to make such reputry to said property as in its sole discretion it may deem necessary or artistante.

It is mutually agreed that:

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1. In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, the beneficiary shall have the right to commence, prosecute in its own name, appear in or defend any action or proceedings, or to make any compromise or settlement in connection with such taking and, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the money's payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by the grandor in such proceedings, shall be paid to the beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by the beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby; and the grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon the beneficiary's requegt.

3. As additional security, grantor hereby assigns to beneficiary during the continuance of these trusts all rents, issues, royalides and profits of the property affected by this deed and of any personal property located thereon. Until grantor shall default in the payment of any lodebtedness secured hereby or in the performance of any agreement hereunder, grantor shall have the right to collect all such rents, issues, royalities and profits earned prior to default as they become due and payable. Upon any default by the grantor hereunder, the beneficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property, or any part thereof, in its own name sue for or otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable attorney's fees, upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as the beneficiary may determine.

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5. The grantor shall notify beneficiary in writing of any sale tract for sale of the above described property and furnish beneficiar form supplied it with such personal information concerning the purch would ordinarily be required of a new loan applicant and shall pay be a service charge.

6. Time is of the essence of this instrument and upon default by the grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in performance of any agreement hereunder, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable by delivery to the trustee of written notice of default and election to sell the trust property, which notice trustee shall cause to be duly liled for record. Upon delivery of said notice of default and election to sell, the beneficiary shall deposit with the trustee this trust deed and all promissory notes and documents evidencing expenditures secured hereby, whereupon the trustees shall fix the time and place of sale and give notice thereof as then required by law.

7. After default and any time prior to five days before the date by the Trustee for the Trustee's sale, the grantor or other person privileged may pay the entire amount then due under this trust deed the obligations secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incu in enforcing the terms of the obligation and trustee's and attorney's not exceeding \$50.00 each) other than such portion of the orincipal sis we
