STIPULATION AND WAIVER

This Stipulation and Waiver shall be entered into the action herein by Petitioner and shall be made a part of the action and no relief other than that stated above shall be granted.

VT

Respondent waives findings of fact, conclusion of law, notice of entry of judgment and all other future proceedings herein and allows that petitioner can set this matter in the nature of a default hearing but entering this document as a part of the court records and the interlocutory decree shall reflect this document in totality.

VII

Each party waives, as necessary, any 60 day waiting period if such there be for the final decree.

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
