The court also orders that, unless both parties file their consent to a dismissal of this proceeding, a final judgment of dissolution be entered upon proper application of either party or on the court's own motion after the expiration of at least six months from the date the court acquired jurisdiction of the respondent. The final judgment shall include such other and further relief as may be necessary to a complete disposition of this proceeding, but entry of the final judgment shall not deprive this court of its jurisdiction over any matter expressly reserved to it in this or the final judgment until a final disposition is made of each such matter.

The stipulation on file herein, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby approved and ordered incorporated into this Judgment, and the parties are ordered to comply with all executory provisions thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner's former name of KAROHS be restored to her upon a Final Judgment of Dissolution herein.

2 automobile and the Suzuki motorcycle.

II

4 All parties agree to execute any and all deeds as necessary
5 to effectuate the transfer of real and personal property above.

III

7 Wife foregoes any spousal support now or in the future.

IV

9 Each of the parties agree that the bills of the parties
10 have been split between them and each shall pay the agreed bill
11 that he or she has agreed to pay and will hold the other harmless
12 for the payment of those bills which each person agrees to pay.

26 if such there be for the final decree.

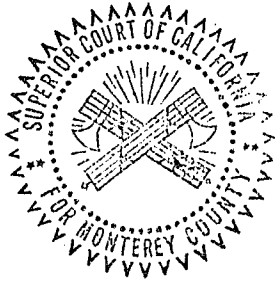
