- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises advances to bear interest as provided in the note;

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right arising from a breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs incurred in connection with such foreclosure. Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgage shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, et the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgagee shall the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.
