MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

- 1. To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby;
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of the advances to bear interest as provided in the note;

- Mortgagee shall be entitled to all compensation and damages received under right of eminent domain, or for any security voluntarily released, same to be applied upon the indebtedness;
- 9. Not to lease or rent the premises, or any part of same, without written consent of the most green
- 10. To promptly notify mortgagee in writing of a transfer of ownership of the premises or any part or interest in same, and to furnish a copy of the instrument of transfer to the mortgagee; a purchaser shall pay interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 or all payments due from the date of transfer; in all other respects this mortgage shall remain in full force and other payments.

The mortgagee may, at his option, in case of default of the mortgagor, perform same in whole or in part and all expenditure made in so doing including the employment of an attorney to secure compilance with the terms of the mortgage or the note shall demand and shall be secured by this mortgage.

Default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained or the expenditure of any portion of the loan for purposes other than those specified in the application, except by written permission of the mortgagee given before the expenditure is made, shall cause the entire indebtedness at the option of the mortgagee to become immediately due and payable without notice and this mortgage subject to foreclosure.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right arising from a breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs incurred in connection with such foreclosure.

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgagee shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgagee shall
