
ORDER

WHEREAS, AN ORDER had been signed by the Klamath County Board of Commissioners on August 15, 1975, approving the issuance of a provisional Temporary Permit No. 75-3 to CHARLES JOCKS, a representative of the Klamath Falls Jaycees, for a carnival site for the period September 9, 1975, through September 16, 1975, and

WHEREAS, an appeal having been received from John C. Argetsinger, and the Board of Commissioners having considered testimony of Will Cedarleaf, Bill Benson and Charles Jocks, the ORDER dated August 15, 1975, is hereby amended to provide the following additional conditions:

- 1. Carnival operator and his employees shall not use toilet facilities or water at the Resale House; these services to be limited to the Bocchi property.
- 2. The Klamath Falls Jaycees shall be held responsible for cleanup of the site and surrounding area.
- 3. Operating hours of the carnival shall be limited to eleven o'clock p.m. on Sundays through Thursday and to twelve midnight on Friday and Saturday.
- 4. All carnival concessions shall be located at the northeast corner of the property which will permit parking on the front and side of the five acres.
