DECREE AND JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER coming on regularly for trial before this Court
on the 29th day of August, 1975, and the Petitioner appearing in
person and by and through Petitioner's attorney, Cash R. Perrine,
and the Respondent appearing in person and by and through
Respondent's attorney, Daniel E. Van Vactor, and both the Peti-
tioner and Respondent having presented their evidence and rested,
the Court granted the Petitioner a dissolution of the marriage and
took the matter of the division of the property of the parties
under advisement and thereafter the Court having rendered its
decision and being fully advised in the premises:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED
