The due date of the last payment shall be on or before December 15, 2010---In the event of transfer of ownership of the premises or any part thereof, I will continue to be liable for payment and the balance shall draw interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 from date of such transfer.

This note is secured by a mortgage, the terms of which are

The mortgagor or subsequent owner may pay all or any part of the loan at any time without penalty.

MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

- 1. To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby;
- Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demolising provements now or hereafter existing; to keep same in good repair; to complete all construction accordance with any agreement made between the parties hereto;
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of advances to bear interest as provided in the note;
- 7. To keep all buildings unceasingly insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards in such company or companies and in such an amount as shall be satisfactory to the mortgage; to deposit with the mortgage all such policies with receipts showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgage; insurance shall be kept in force by the mortgagor in case of foreclosure until the period of redemption expires;

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- B. Mortgagee shall be entitled to all compensation and damages received under right of eminent domain, or for any security voluntarily released, same to be applied upon the indebtedness;
- 9. Not to lease or rent the premises, or any part of same, without written consent of the mortgagee;

10. To promptly notify mortgaged m writing of a transfer of ownership of the premises or any part or interest in same, and to furnish a copy of the instrument of transfer to the mortgaged: a purchaser shall pay interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 of all payments due from the date of transfer; in all other respects this mortgage shall remain in full force and effect.

The mortgagee may, at his option, in case of default of the mortgagor, perform same in whole or in part and all expenditure made in so doing including the employment of an attorney to secure compliance with the terms of the mortgage or the note shall draw interest at the rate provided in the note and all such expenditures shall be immediately repayable by the mortgagor without demand and shall be secured by this mortgage.

Default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained or the expenditure of any portion of the loan for purpose other than those specified in the application, except by written permission of the mortgage given before the expenditure is made shall cause the entire indebtedness at the option of the mortgage to become immediately due and payable without notice and this mortgage subject to foreclosure.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right arising from a breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other cost incurred in competion with such foreclosure.

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgagee shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession collect the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgagee shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.

The covenants and agreements herein shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors an assigns of the respective parties hereto.
